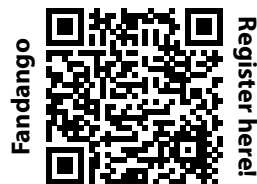

Construction Work Still Being Performed

While the Fitness Center is open for business, there are some areas that are still under construction/renovation. All patrons must access the Fitness Center using the new entrance on the west side of the building. The old entrance on the south side of the building is restricted to authorized construction project personnel only. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause as we continue to make improvements to the Fitness Center for the Schriever SFB community.

Fitness Center Parking Lot Construction

Now – July 2026

The Fitness Center military construction project is now in the third phase, which includes building a second new parking lot and repairing the original parking lot. During this period, Fitness Center patrons should follow these parking priorities in order:

- 1) The new North (upper) Fitness Center parking lot. Vehicles must be parked in marked spaces. Curb parking in this lot blocks access for emergency services.
- 2) Alternate parking lots at the soccer field or baseball field.
- 3) Street parking on the north side of Falcon Pkwy between Hahn Ave and Voyager St. This will be permitted only during peak use times, 6 – 9 a.m. and 3 – 5 p.m. daily. (Unless impacted by snow.)

Notes: Street parking is not permitted on Falcon Pkwy immediately south of the Fitness Center in the coned area. Cars parked here limit visibility for drivers navigating the Falcon Pkwy/Voyager St intersection. No parking is permitted in the original south (lower) lot during this phase of construction. Tickets will be issued to vehicles parked in violation of these rules.

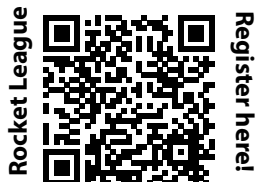

FUN FACTS

President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed June 14, 1916 as Flag Day. As did President Calvin Coolidge in 1927. It was officially declared a national holiday in 1949 when it was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Harry Truman. Although it is not a federal holiday, Flag Day is celebrated annually across the country.

There have been 27 official versions of the U.S. flag. Each time a new state joined the Union, a new star was added. The current 50-star flag became official on July 4, 1960, after Hawaii became a state.

The current 50-star design was created in 1958 by Robert Heft, a 17-year-old high school student. He designed it for a school project and originally received a B-minus. When President Dwight D. Eisenhower selected his design from more than 1,500 submissions, his grade was changed to an A.

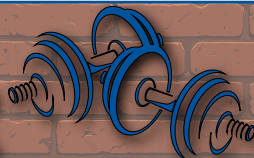
