

The Puzzler

SUDOKU PLUS


How to play: As with regular Sudoku, the objective of the puzzle is to fill the grid with the numbers 1-6 so that each row, column and 2x3 group of squares contains each number exactly once.

Instead of pre-filled squares acting as clues, the Sudoku Plus grid is divided into irregularly shaped sections called 'cages'. Each cage contains a clue number in the corner of one of its squares. This number indicates the sum total of the numbers that should be entered in the cage's squares.

A completed cage must not contain any single number more than once.


One cage has been filled in as an example.


