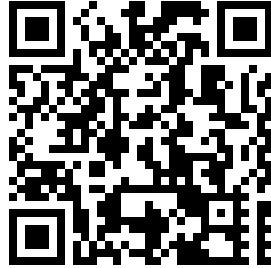


Bright Futures Screening

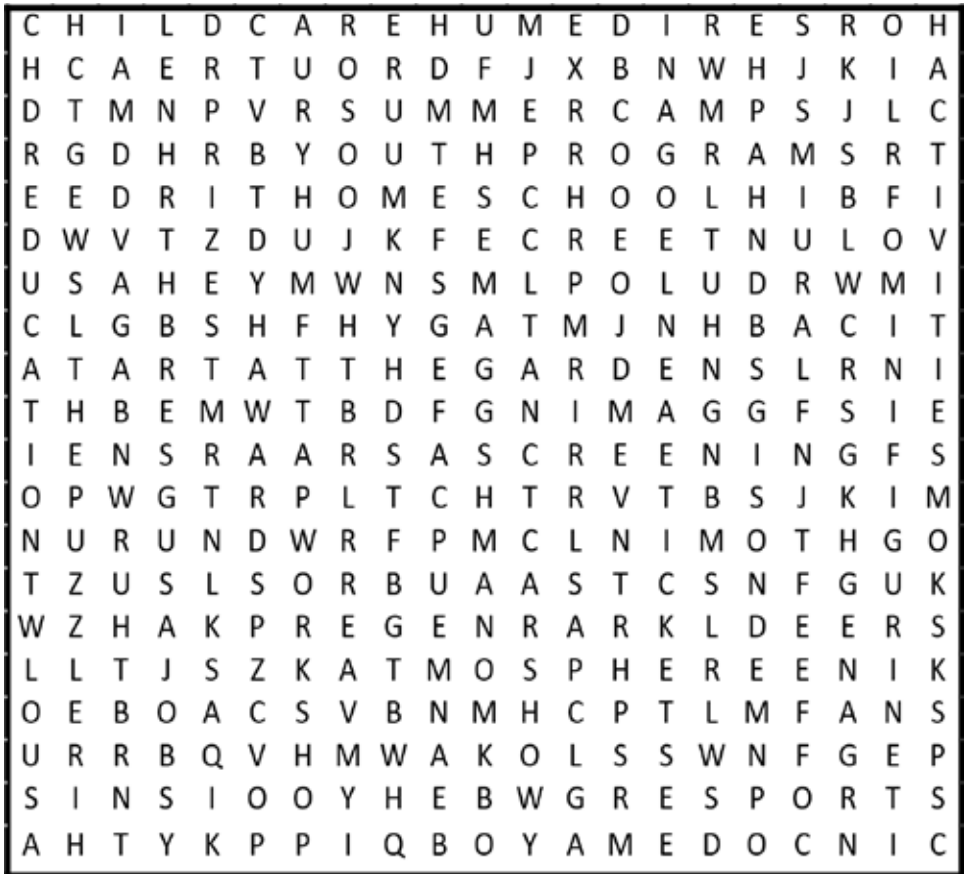
